"The logo for the Hobart Ladies Badminton Association is a modern and bold representation that balances athletic strength with femininity. Drawing inspiration from the structured lines of a badminton racket, the design incorporates clean, geometric elements that reflect the sport's precision and energy. Contrasting these straight lines are smooth, flowing curves that symbolise femininity and movement.

The icon subtly shows a stylised "H" for Hobart, which, when repeated, forms a flower shape as a symbol of friendship, community and growth among players. This icon can be used independently, offering versatility across brand applications."
