Easter roster: At its meeting on Thursday $23^{\text {rd }}$ March, the Committee confirmed the following arrangements for the conclusion of the Easter roster:
a) The teams that finish $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the roster will play off in the grand final on Tuesday $4^{\text {th }}$ April. The teams that finish $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ will play each other, and the teams that finish $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ will also play each other.
b) There will be a presentation to the winners and runners-up immediately after the games finish.
c) Games for all other divisions will be as normal for the week.

## Autumn and Winter Arrangements 2023

1 Wednesday and Thursday mornings: play will continue as normal - ie, social games will be played.
2 Division 2B (Tuesday mornings), play will continue as normal - ie, social games will be played.
3 Tuesday morning roster play: (Open to all members)
Because of the number of players who will be absent over the autumn and winter and the difficulty in finding fill in players, the Committee has decided to run two shorter periods of competition.

A short 5-week Autumn Roster will be played from Tuesday 2nd of May to the $30^{\text {th }}$ of May (including a final). Competition will follow the same general guidelines used in the Easter Roster.

This will be followed by a Lightning Doubles roster from Tuesday $6^{\text {th }}$ of June to Tuesday $4^{\text {th }}$ of July. Briefly, the format will consist of:
i) Four ladies of similar standard in each pool. Each week each player will play with and against each of the other players in the pool. There will be three matches per player.
ii) Each player is then ranked according to matches won. If there is a tie, players will be ranked according to games won. If there is still a tie, players will be ranked according to points.
iii) The top ranked player will MOVE to the next pool UP for the following week's games. The two middle ranked players will STAY in the SAME pool for the following week's games. The lowest ranked player will MOVE to the next pool DOWN for the following week's games.
iv) You must organise your own fill-in. If your fill-in WINS, you STAY in the same pool for the following week. If your fill-in LOSES, you move DOWN for the following week.

How to nominate for playing in the Autumn Roster and/or Lightning roster Note that you only need to complete this form if you want to play or fill in in either or both rosters.
a) Complete the hard copy form that will be available from Tuesday $28^{\text {th }}$ March and hand to your Div Rep. OR fill in the form on line on our website (available shortly).
b) You can nominate to play in one of the above options or both.
c) Entry is open to all players in the Association.
d) If you are unable to commit to all games in the competition you can nominate as a fill in.
e) Nominations close on Tuesday $11^{\text {th }}$ April when the Committee will meet to select teams.
